- Based on individual credentials, each and every faculty will be privileged to perform clinical procedures in their respective department/field.
- Individual privileging forms will be completed by the applicant doctor of his/her respective department on the date of joining. This will be reviewed by the HOD, verified by the Principal and approved by the Correspondent.
- These forms will be filed in the individual employee file maintained by HR coordinator.
- Staff can request their academic and clinical related privilege and the same will be verified and approved by higher authorities.

Faculties also suggested during the training that HOD's signature field to be included in the privilege application form. Both Credentialing & Privileging process will be revised once in a year for all faculties.

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

This program had given a wide knowledge in improving the quality of teaching. The attendance details were documented and feedback was collected through Google forms and participation certificate was dispatched to the participants.

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
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
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

The attendance details were documented along with the post training Questionnaire and feedback by HR coordinator and QMS Assistant for drafting the corrective action measures if any.

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
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

SUMMARY

The program started after the welcome address and motivational short speech by Principal Dr. Vasanthakumari. A. The speaker of the program was Dr. James Bhagath. He discussed about the antibiotic policy that is being followed in the college as per the guidelines. An antibiotic policy is a set of principles to guide implementation of prudent and rational antimicrobial prescribing in the hospital. An antibiotic guideline can help to improve patient outcomes, reduce the cost of patient care, enhance cost savings, improve quality of care, reduce variations in antibiotic prescription amongst clinicians and may be an effective means of changing behavior in antimicrobial prescribing.

A multidisciplinary antibiotic management team can be set up to write the antibiotic guideline and policy. He discussed regarding the prescription of antibiotics and other drugs which must be followed as per our drug formulary designed by our institution. The policy should contain antibiotics for general use, reserved and restricted antibiotics; recommendations for principles of antimicrobial stewardship, alternatives for antibiotic use in case of allergy, guidance for intravenous to oral switch etc. The antibiotic policy and guidelines are living documents and therefore should be reviewed at regular intervals. They should be updated according to current medical knowledge, clinical practice and local circumstances. The training was given to teaching staff. This program mainly focused with regard to the quality improvement and proper knowledge about antibiotic policy of APDCH.

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
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

- He informed us that constraints on funding, judging panels for grants and peer reviewers will select proposals, not only include outstanding science or research, but also incorporate carefully thought-out plans to reach end-users, represent value for money, with methodology that's clearly detailed and budgeted. - A systematic review is an objective, reproducible method to find answers to a certain research question, by collecting all available studies related to that question and reviewing and analyzing their results. A meta-analysis differs from a systematic review in that it uses statistical methods on estimates from two or more different studies to form a pooled estimate.

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

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

- A sentinel event is a Patient Safety Event. a careful investigation and analysis of Patient Safety Events (events not primarily related to the natural course of the patient's illness or underlying condition), as well as evaluation of corrective actions, is essential to reduce risk and prevent patient harm.
- The Sentinel Event Policy explains how the health care organizations that have experienced a serious patient safety event to protect the patient, improve systems, and prevent further harm.
- Ms Preeethi, MBA Quality manager presented the lecture that hospitals need a clear responsibility to not only investigate, but report on, sentinel events for the sake of their standard operating procedures and the health of future patients.
- The objective of the session was to facilitate the improvement or development of reporting systems that receive information that can be used to improve patient safety. The Sentinel Event Policy had to be framed for APDCH was also discussed by her.
- The presentation outlines the requirements for an adverse event reporting system, including the mechanism for collecting reports, the capacity to perform investigations, the expertise required, the technical infrastructure, and the capacity to disseminate findings.
- The teaching and non-teaching staffs attended the session with great interest. Feedback forms were collected at the end of the program.

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


- > Hospital waste is a potential health hazard to the health care workers, public and flora and fauna of the area. Segregation is the most crucial step in bio-medical waste management. Effective segregation alone can ensure effective biomedical waste management. The bins and bags should carry the biohazard symbol indicating the nature of waste to the patients
- > All staff members, faculty, hospital workers have been given a one day training on BMW rules -2016 by guest speaker DR.SURESH organized by the hospital infection control committee.
- > The latest guidelines for segregation of bio-medical waste recommend the following color coding:
- Red bag syringes (without needles), soiled gloves, catheters, IV tubes etc. Should be all disposed of in a red colored bag, which will later be incinerated.
- Yellow bag all dressings, bandages and cotton swabs with body fluids, blood bags, human anatomical waste, and body parts are to be discarded in yellow bags.
- Cardboard box with blue marking glass vials, ampoules, other glass ware is to be discarded in a cardboard box with a blue marking/sticker.
- White puncture proof container (PPC) needles, sharps, blades are disposed of in a white translucent puncture proof container.
- Black bags these are to be used for non-bio-medical waste

The session was concluded by creating surveillance groups within hospitals and everyone would be held accountable for misconduct and improper disposal of waste. Consequences could be implemented where teaching staffs would be required to monitor the clinical students if they violate the rules.
